- Required -** 1 (8x10 or 9x12) **spiral sketchbook**
Optional - 17" x 22" paper portfolio

PHOTOGRAPHY I : 10 rolls of TRI x 400 black and white negative film 35 mm (24 exposures).
1 pack of 8 x 10 black and white photo paper, 25 sheets (this is supplemental, the pack will be refilled many times throughout the school year).
1 subject hard covered binder for negative storage.
1 second hand 35 mm slr film camera with a working built in light meter.

None of these items (except the binder) are necessary on the first day of school.

Prices vary greatly. I have found that B and H Photo in NYC has the best deals.

PHOTOGRAPHY II: 5 rolls of Tri X 400 35 mm black and white film (24 exposures).

Second hand 35 mm slr camera.
