## Riverton City Council's 2016-2017 Strategic Plan Executive Summary

In March 2016, the City Council approved the Strategic Plan for the 2016-17 fiscal budget year. The Strategic Plan has been implemented as the instrument used in prioritizing resources and guiding the budget process for the upcoming fiscal year. The Council has identified six fundamental priorities, each established with quantifiable goals so progress can be measured.



The fundamental areas of focus, along a brief overview of related goals are:

1. **Economic Development** – focus will be given to the development agreements for the CenterCal Development in the Western Commercial District (WCD) and to Riverton's Downtown area;
2. **Maintaining the Sense of Community** – this priority identifies specific City parks in need of major repairs or replacement of playground equipment;
3. **Communication and Branding** – continued effort will be provided to the new website and social media outlets;
4. **Infrastructure and Transportation** – much attention has been given to infrastructure needs within the WCD, bicycle lanes, and analysis for a 5-million gallon water tank;
5. **Emergency Response** – emergency exercises will be scheduled to help ensure City staff is prepared for emergencies; and
6. **Safety and Risk Management** – this propriety ensures that City departments will receive specific safety trainings such as confined space entry.

The Strategic Plan is the catalyst for the 2016-2017 budget. The specific items in the Council's plan were included in the Departments' budget requests. Please refer to the City's website ([www.rivertoncity.com](http://www.rivertoncity.com)) to read the Strategic Plan in its entirety.

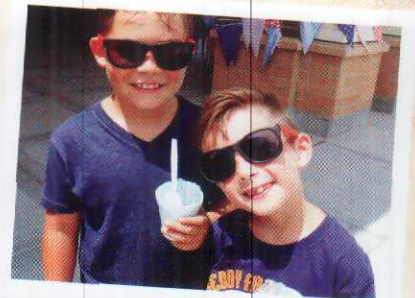

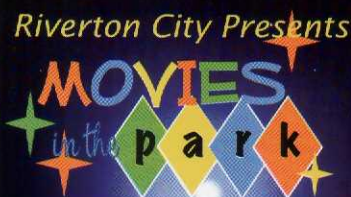
