


Trash Collection

Tuesdays are the scheduled trash pickup days for all City residents. Please place your bagged trash at your curbside after 6:00pm on Monday and no later than 7:00am on Tuesdays.

- 6 trash bag limit - bags cannot exceed 50lbs.
- Trash cans placed at the curb will not be emptied.
- Items not within a bag will not be picked up unless prior arrangements with Stevens Disposal have been made.
- Residents exceeding the 6 bag limit must make prior pick-up arrangements with Stevens Disposal. There is an additional \$1.00 per bag fee.
- **Special Pick-ups:** Pick-ups for items such as appliances, furniture, televisions, computer monitors, and carpeting cost \$5.00 per item. Residents must contact Stevens Disposal at 1-800-779-0344 to make arrangements to pay for pickup.
- For pricing information for pickup of demolition materials (such as bricks, drywall, etc.) please call Stevens Disposal.
- For Hazardous Waste disposal call Lenawee County Solid Waste at 517-264-4546.
- **HOLIDAY TRASH COLLECTION** - *If a holiday falls on a Monday or Tuesday, trash pick-up will occur on Wednesday.*

Curbside Recycling

The City of Adrian offers curbside recycling on a bi-weekly schedule to city residents for an additional fee of \$31.80 per year. To sign up for recycling please call 517-264-4826.

All recyclable materials can be deposited in the same container.

Accepted items: newspapers, magazines and cereal box-type paperboard; clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars, plastics #1 through #7, aluminum and steel cans; brown and white corrugated cardboard.

CURBSIDE YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Curbside Yard Waste Specifications - *Please note changes to accepted yardwaste bags!*

Yard waste is described as grass clippings, leaves, material from flower beds, garden waste, and twigs smaller than a quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) inch in diameter.

Yard waste collection will be provided to areas approved for residential refuse collection. In order for the yard waste to be picked up, the yard waste must be placed in **biodegradable and/ or compostable paper bags** and must not weigh more than fifty (50) pounds. Unapproved containers (**including plastic bags**) will not be picked up for collection.



Curbside Yard Waste Collection Schedule

Curbside yard waste collection will occur in the spring and again in the fall. Collection dates will be announced prior to each session.

Residents may take yard waste to the Adrian Compost Site from May to December.

Compost Site Hours:

May 4th - December 7th

Tuesdays: 12pm-7pm

Saturdays: 8am-2pm

Closed on Saturday, November 30th

Residents interested in using the Compost Site can obtain a free window sticker from the City Clerk located on the second floor of City Hall (one per address-stickers do not expire).

- Accepted items: yard waste such as leaves, grass, brush, branches & garden debris
- Items not accepted: trash, building materials and pet waste

Residents must empty their own yard waste at the Compost Site. Please contact 517-264-4888 with Compost Site questions.

Compost/Woodchip Sales

Compost & woodchips are available for no cost at the Compost Site (self-load). Compost & woodchips are available for delivery at \$50/2 cubic yards (prepay at City Hall)

Bundled Brush & Branches

Brush and branches may also be collected during the yard waste collection periods but must meet the following guidelines:

- Tied in bundles no longer than three (3) feet.
- Bundles are placed parallel with the curb.
- Bundles weigh less than fifty (50) pounds.

Brush/Branches will NOT be accepted in bags, boxes or any other containers. Special brush pickups, due to weather events, will be conducted at the discretion of the Parks & Engineering Director.
