Due to the passage of Proposal 3 in 2018, the Michigan Constitution provides voters with a Straight Party Ticket voting option.

If you select one of the political parties in the Straight Party Ticket section, *but would like to vote for a candidate of a different party for any of the partisan races*, you may vote for that candidate.

The remainder of the partisan section will default to the candidates for the political party selected in the Straight Party Ticket section.
