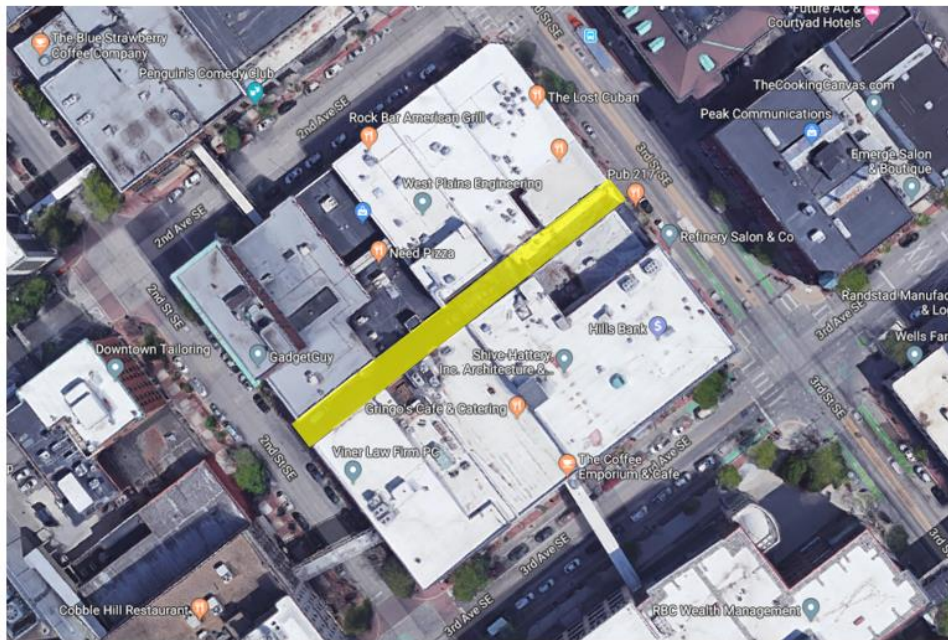

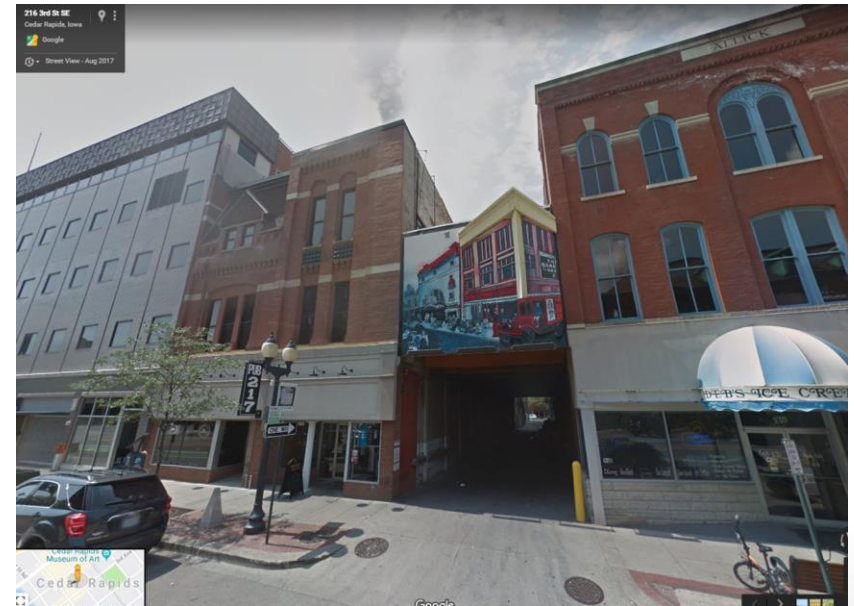




# Market After Dark Projection Art Opportunity

- Dubuque *Art on the River*
- City works with artists to create a public gallery of sculptures up and down 3<sup>rd</sup> Street. Commission percentage supports visual arts programming across the city.

Welcome to Art on the River Driftless, Dubuque's premier public art display at the Port of Dubuque. The City of Dubuque is committed to fostering arts and culture in the community. Beyond a display of beautiful, thought-provoking art, this investment is in the community and the arts industry in our community.

Art on the River is a program presided over by the Arts and Cultural Affairs Advisory Commission. Each year new artworks by talented artists are selected to enhance the Mississippi Riverwalk. Selected artists receive a stipend from the City of Dubuque for exhibiting their sculpture for the year. All of the artwork is for sale and will be on display until the summer of 2019.
