**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Sergent called the meeting to order at approximately 5:30 P.M.

**PUBLIC HEARING TO RECEIVE CITIZEN INPUT TO APPLY FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT - CV (CDBG).**

Mayor Sergent opened the Public Hearing. She inquired of the City Clerk if anyone had expressed a wish to speak on this matter. City Clerk Bowen stated, "No." No one on-line wished to speak.

**TIME SET TO VOTE TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION TO APPLY FOR \$900,000 IN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG-CV) FUNDS.**

**ADOPTED A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO BEGIN CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS.**

Commissioner Currin what the money at the bottom of the resolution was for. Attorney Burnette stated that it was the money that the City would be paying the landowners to run the lines across their property.
