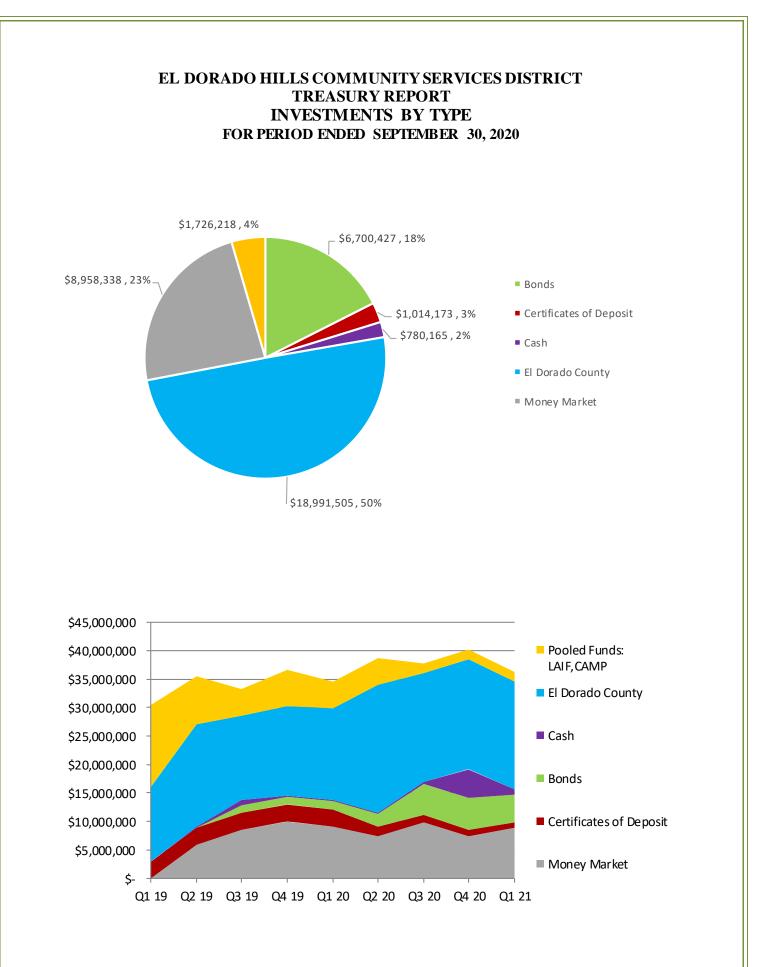

7. The checking accounts include checking and certificates of deposit accounts held in the name of the District.

 The fiducuary funds with CalPERS are restricted long-term assets and are not considered a current financial resource. Pension values reported are as of most recent Actuarial Report dated June 30, 2018.

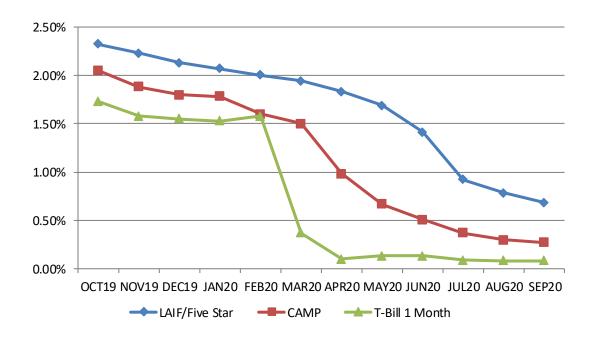

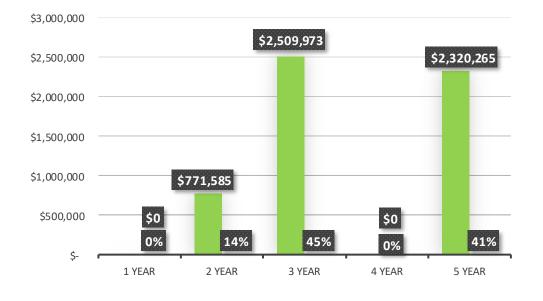
