SWIMMING POOL SAFETY TIPS— Please review the following information to keep your pool a safe and fun summer activity for your family.

Supervision

- Never take your eyes off children in the water—not even for a minute! Parents may think they’ll hear splashing and screaming when a child is in trouble, but when a child drowns, it usually happens quickly and silently.
- Don’t allow a young child in the pool without an adult.
- Knowing how to swim doesn’t make a child drown-proof. Never use flotation devices as a substitute for supervision.

If a child is missing, check the pool first. Seconds count in preventing death or disability.

Install Barriers at Home Pools

- A barrier, such as a fence that is at least 4 feet high, must surround the pool or spa. The gate or door must be self-closing and self-latching with the latch out of a child’s reach. If the house serves as one side of the barrier, there must be an alarm on doors that have direct access to the pool.
- For above-ground and inflatable pools with ladders, **remove** or secure the **ladder** when the pool is not in use.
- A power safety pool cover or safety cover for spas is another barrier option. The safety cover must meet ASTM standard F1346-91. If the safety cover meets standards, additional barriers, such as fencing, may be optional—check with your local city building department.



Police Chief’s Corner:

The City of Everson has installed new flashing, amber, crosswalk lights at the intersection of Main Street and Washington Street. As pedestrians approach the north / south crosswalk at this intersection, there is a push button system that activates the flashing lights. It is very important to know that just because the button has been pushed, and the lights are flashing, that vehicles will not automatically stop for pedestrians entering the crosswalk, so please watch for traffic.

Under RCW 46.61.235.1, motorists can be issued a \$139.00 infraction for: Fail to Yield to Pedestrian in Crosswalk. Please Be Safe.
