DOG/CAT LICENSES ARE DUE FOR RENEWAL IN JANUARY

All dogs and cats over the age of 6 months must be licensed every year in January before January 30th to avoid incurring a late fee. A \$25.00 late fee will be assessed for all licenses acquired after January 30th.

To obtain a license, a dog/cat's rabies shot MUST have an expiration date of 10/31 or later. Any dog/cat with a shot expiring before that date must be re-boostered before licensing. This is a State law.

You may obtain a license at Borough Hall, Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM, or Please complete the following application, for each license needed, and returning the application form(s), together with your dog/cat's rabies vaccination certificate showing the expiration date, with a check made payable to the "BOROUGH OF FARMINGDALE" and a self-addressed, stamped envelope to:
