Re: Political Signage

Dear All Frelinghuysen Residents, Candidates, Campaign Committees and Candidate Supporters:

Just a friendly reminder now that election season is over, all political signage, including lawn signs, must be removed. Pursuant to Ordinance LDO-513A(8) political signs are permitted forty-five (45) days in advance of election day and five (5) days following election day without a resident, candidate, campaign committee or supporter first having obtained the appropriate permit. Our Ordinance is content neutral in this regard. Since election day was November 3, 2020, any signage still in place is in violation of the Ordinance and requires a permit. If a resident, candidate, campaign committee or supporter wishes to maintain a sign in place at this time, you must first apply to the Zoning Official and/or the Construction Official, depending on the size, location and permanency of the sign, for the appropriate permit. In the meantime, pending permit approval or denial, please remove any signs until the permit is acted upon by the appropriate official. Violations may be subject to enforcement action by appropriate Township official.
