CURBSIDE COLLECTION

DO'S AND DON'TS

The City WILL collect: ✓

- ✓ Yard waste (limbs, grass clippings, leaves)
- ✓ Bulk waste (furniture, small appliances, large toys, mattresses, large metal appliances)

The City WILL NOT collect: ✗

- ✗ Construction materials
- ✗ Commercial waste (waste from a contracted job*)
- ✗ Hazardous waste**
- ✗ Compressed gas or liquid containers (propane tanks, gas cans/drums, paint cans)

DO: ✓

- ✓ **DO** put items in your **green** trash roll cart whenever possible. **Rule of Thumb: If it will fit in your roll cart, put it there**
- ✓ **DO** place curbside items **3 feet** from obstructions such as utility poles, mailboxes, or vehicles
- ✓ **DO** neatly place limbs or yard cuttings adjacent to the street in piles of reasonable size (limbs should be cut so they are a maximum of **6 inches wide x 6 ft long**)
- ✓ **DO** contact the City for a dump trailer for significant amounts of bulk items
- ✓ **DO** place recyclable material in County provided blue recycle roll carts (if you do not have one, contact 864.942.8567)

DO NOT: ✗

- ✗ **DO NOT** mix piles of trash. **City staff CANNOT collect mixed piles and will skip them.** Limbs should be in separate piles from leaves or grass clippings. It is **illegal** to comeingle anything
- ✗ **DO NOT** bag yard waste, including grass clippings, for loose curbside collection
- ✗ **DO NOT** set out loose trash that can be scattered by animals or weather. Instead, place these items in your roll cart
- ✗ **DO NOT** dump on **ANY** property other than your own. **DO NOT** block sidewalks, gutters, or streets. Dumping on another's property is illegal and may result in a fine
- ✗ **DO NOT** leave trash roadside for extended periods of time. If the City recently collected in your neighborhood, consider transporting items to a convenience center or the landfill

*If you hire someone (a contractor) to perform the work, they must haul off the material. This includes yard waste

Noncompliance with required corrective action may result in penalties per City Ordinance. Penalties can include fees reflecting the actual cost by the City to abate the violation and/or fines of up \$1,087.50.
