## HOW TO FILE A PROTECTION FROM ABUSE PACKET

## **EFFECTIVE JANUARY 2, 2025**

Pursuant to the Administrative Order signed by President Judge Trish Corbett dated November 13, 2024, ALL <u>Emergency</u> motions/petitions including, but not limited to, Temporary Protection From Abuse petitions <u>MUST</u> be presented in person. Additionally, all <u>contested</u> motions/petitions <u>MUST</u> be presented in person in Family Motion Court, which is held every day at 9:00 a.m. Such <u>emergency</u> and <u>contested</u> motions/petitions <u>CANNOT</u> be emailed.

To petition the Court for a Temporary Protection from Abuse Order, you must complete a PFA Packet, which includes a data sheet, petition, and order.

PFA packets can be obtained from the **Family Court Administrator's Office**, located at 123 Wyoming Avenue, Scranton, PA, 18503, First Floor. They can also be obtained on the Lackawanna County website — <u>www.lackawannacounty.org</u> - under <u>Government</u>, then click <u>Family Court</u>, then scroll to the bottom and click <u>Forms</u>. There is a PDF as well as a fillable form.

## You must complete <u>EACH AND EVERY</u> page of the packet. Any lines left blank <u>WILL</u> resort in a delay in processing.
