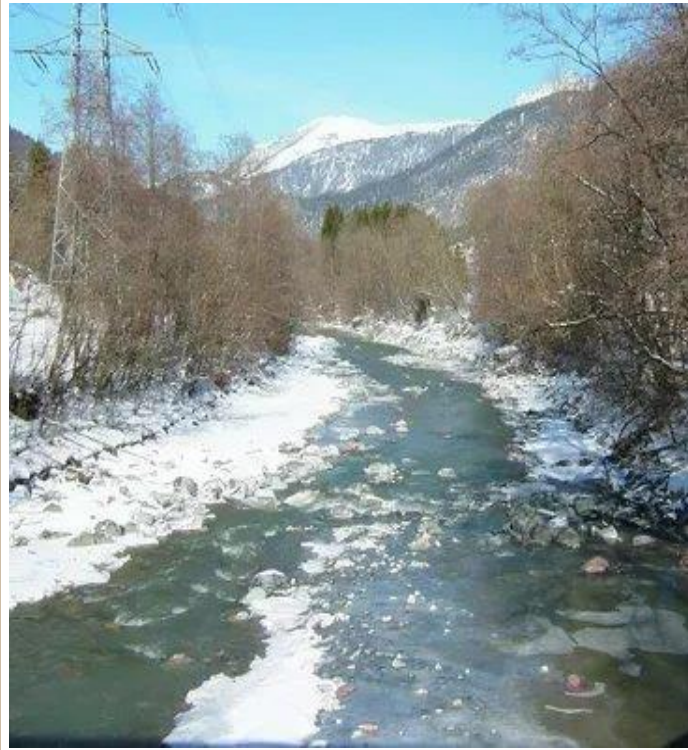

Vandling was originally called Clintonville, after the Clinton Coal Colliery.

Lumbering was the first industry in the area until coal was discovered near the surface for easy mining.
