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SUMMARY OF FLOODPLAIN IMPACTS

Floodplain Affected: Special Flood Hazard Zone AE associated with Reeders Run

Description of Project:

The Warren County Transportation Improvement District (WCTID) and the City of Lebanon in conjunction with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) proposes the widening of State Route 63 (SR 63) to a three-lane section and lowering the speed limit to 35 MPH. Markey Road will be realigned and connected to a newly constructed roundabout at the intersection of Markey Road and SR63. A shared-use path will be added along the north side of SR63 and the existing bridge over Reeders Run will be replaced to accommodate the expanded roadway and shared-use path. The total approximate project length is 0.44 miles.

Why must this project be located in the Floodplain?

The project is necessary to improve roadway safety and increase pedestrian access along the project corridor. The project will involve the widening of SR63 and the addition of a shared-use path along the north side of SR63. To accommodate for the road widening and shared-use path, the existing bridge over Reeders Run will be replaced. The existing bridge over Reeders Run is located in the floodplain; therefore, project construction must occur within the floodplain.

What alternative sites were considered, if any?


No other alternatives were considered for the section of the of the project within the floodplain. The existing conditions for the section of the project within the floodplain are not adequate for the proposed roadway expansion, roundabout, and shared-used path; therefore, the project construction must exist within the floodplain.
