



Traffic Advisory Lebanon, Ohio

On December 3, 2022, the City of Lebanon will host the Lebanon Horse Drawn Carriage Parade and Festival. The festival will take place in the downtown area and will result in the detour of several routes.

Effective Saturday, December 3, 2022, at 6:00 a.m.:

- Broadway (U.S. Route 42 and State Route 48) will be closed to traffic until midnight.
- Broadway will be closed between Main Street (State Route 63/123) and Silver Street.

Additional road closures will be in effect during the Carriage Parades between the hours of 12:30 p.m. through 2:30 p.m. and again at 6:30 p.m. through 8:30 p.m. The following routes will be affected:

- Broadway (State Route 48/US Route 42) from Monroe Road to South Street.
- Warren Street (US Route 42) will be closed at East Street
- Main Street (State Routes 63 and 123) from West Street to East Street

All travelers in the area should expect delays and plan accordingly.

Operators of **semi-tractor trailers** are encouraged to seek an alternate route and *not* to enter the downtown area.
