Councilman Harrison moved to approve the recommendation from the McAlester Cemetery Board to expend Cemetery Perpetual Care Funds for the purchase of one (1) John Deere Gator TH 6X4 and the purchase of sixteen (16) trees. The motion was seconded by Councilman Smith.

Before the vote, Manager Stasiak explained that the applicant, Tanner Consulting, L.L.C., was requesting the closure of a partial easement in Block 328, lots 5, 6 and 7. He added that the applicant had proposed to re-route the City sewer lines around the front of the new structure. He stated that the Planning Commission had voted unanimously to recommend approval of the partial closure.

Mayor Priddle commented that this would create a new larger Braum's east of the current store's location. There was no further discussion, and the vote was taken as follows:

4. Consider and act upon a change in zoning from I-1 (Light Industrial) to C-5 (Highway Commercial). (Peter J. Stasiak, City Manager)

Executive Summary

This item involves a motion to approve and act upon changing the existing zoning for a 4.70 acre parcel of land located at the Southside Industrial Park from I-1 (Light Industrial) to C-5 (Highway Commercial) and authorizing the Mayor to sign the attached Ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. <u>2385</u>

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE GENERAL ZONING ORDINANCE AND ACCOMPANYING MAP THERETO KNOWN AS GENERAL ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 1843 (1989), BY CHANGING THE CLASSIFICATIONS OF THE ZONING DISTRICT FOR: A TRACT OF LAND IN THE NE/4, SE/4 OF SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 5 NORTH, RANGE

14 EAST, OF THE INDIAN BASE MERIDIAN, PITTSBURG COUNTY, STATE OF FOLLOWS: PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS MORE OKLAHOMA. BEING COMMENCING AT THE NE CORNER OF THE SE/4 OF SECTION 24; THENCE S89°03'30"W ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF THE SE/4 A DISTANCE OF 80.00 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING: THENCE S01°11'26"E PARALLEL TO THE EAST LINE OF SAID SE/4 A DISTANCE OF 346.50 FEET; THENCE S89°03'30"W PARALLEL TO THE NORTH LINE OF THE SAID SE/4 A DISTANCE OF 590.85 FEET; THENCE N01°11'26"W PARALLEL TO THE EAST LINE OF SAID SE/4 A DISTANCE OF 346.50 FEET; THENCE N89°03'30"E ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF SAID SE/4 A DISTANCE OF 590.85 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING FROM I-1 (LIGHT INDUSTRIAL) TO C-5 (HIGHWAY COMMERCIAL).

Vice-Mayor Browne moved for approval of <u>ORDINANCE NO. 2385</u>, seconded by Councilman Harrison.

Before the vote, Manager Stasiak explained that the City of McAlester was requesting this change in zoning and that the Planning Commission had unanimously voted to recommend the change. He added that this section of property had been surveyed so the Council would have a better idea of what it was worth and there was someone interested in building an office complex on that site.

Councilman Karr asked if all of the property would eventually be rezoned. Manager Stasiak stated that yes and this was addressed at this time to square up the property.

5. Submission and presentation of the Proposed 2011 Capital Budget per the City Charter by March 15th. (*Peter J. Stasiak, City Manager*)

Executive Summary

This item involves the submission and presentation of the Proposed 2011 Capital Budget to the City Council per the City Charter.

Vice-Mayor Browne moved to open the floor for the Submission and presentation of the Proposed 2011 Capital Budget per the City Charter by March 15th. The motion was seconded by Councilman Harrison.

Manager Stasiak reviewed the steps taken to develop the five (5) year CIP for year 2011-2012 through 2015-2016. He commented that it had been difficult to develop the plan without knowing what the coming year's budget would allow. During his review Manager Stasiak highlighted what items had been prioritized by the department heads. Manager Stasiak also reviewed the Charter requirements with the Council. He stated that if needed by the Council a workshop could be scheduled.

There was then a lengthy discussion among the Council concerning various alternatives available for the transportation needs of the meter readers, the absence of street resurfacing, the two (2) Utility trucks equipped with salt spreaders and snow pushers, the value of the streets, the matching funds for the airport grant and the Army Reserve building that would be turned over to the City sometime in the near future. The Council also discussed the need for a workshop for the CIP as well as a workshop for the landfill. Those workshops were attentively scheduled for March 17, 2011 for the landfill and March 24, 2011 for the CIP.

There was no further discussion, and no vote was taken on this item.

New Business

No new business.

City Manager's Report

Manager Stasiak reported that the street signs around the Emerson school area had been replaced. He explained that the City was focusing replacing the street signs in the school areas and would then move into the other areas of the city. He stated that there had not been any fees waived in February.

Remarks and Inquiries By City Council

Councilman Karr asked who would be responsible for repair of a citizen's yard that had been damaged when the water line had been connected to. He announced that "Grand Dad's Catfish" was supposed to open this weekend. He added that the restaurant in the old golf pro shop was probably another month away.

Councilman Mason stated that he had received numerous complaints about the size of the loads going to the landfill.

Councilman Smith did not have any comments for the evening.

Councilman Harrison asked about the portable water pressure vehicle he had seen.

David Medley explained that the City would be bringing in three (3) high pressure tanks while the Carl Albert water storage tank was down for repairs.

Vice-Mayor Browne commented about calls concerning the ten foot trailer length limit at the landfill. He inquired about the possibility of moving a street light to the corner of the Komar entrance. He commented that he had spent an entire day at the Hospital recently and was very pleased with the professional atmosphere. He stated that the library committee was still working very hard toward getting the old Boy's and Girl's Club building as the new library and he reminded everyone that the Italian Festival was coming up soon.

John Modzelewski explained that the length limit for trailers going to the landfill had been changed to twelve feet and that he had been speaking with PSO about the lighting situation at the entrance to the Komar warehouse.

Mayor Priddle expressed his appreciation for the sense of urgency and continued work on the water storage tanks. He added that it was a great move forward.

Recess Council Meeting

Mayor Priddle asked for a motion to recess the Regular Meeting to convene the Authorities. Vice-Mayor Browne moved to recess the Regular Meeting and convene the Authorities. The motion was seconded by Councilman Karr and the vote was taken as follows:

Mayor Priddle declared the motion carried, and the Regular Meeting was recessed at 7:23 P.M.

This contract is entered into this 11th day of March, 2011 by and between Rainbow Fireworks, Inc. and Stephen A. Showalter, President, designated herein as the "SELLER" and CITY OF McALESTER, designated herein as the "PURCHASER" for One Class "B" Fireworks Production to be held on the 4th day of July, 2011.

- - YES SELLER will include the services of a Pyrotechnic Operator (shooter) to take charge of, set up, and fire the display, along with such help as he deems necessary to perform the fireworks display safely, and in accordance with such Federal, State or Local laws that might be applied.

 - YES Z SELLER will include a CERTIFICATE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE POLICY of \$2,000,000 aggregate coverage.
 - YES PURCHASER will furnish the secured minimum safety distances established by the SELLER after an on-site inspection of the proposed firing location.
 - YES **PURCHASER** will provide adequate police protection and/or other adequate security to maintain these distances.

AGREEMENT FOR FIREWORKS DISPLAY

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 6th day of January 2011, by and between Hance Pyrotechnics, whose principal place of business is Tahlequah, Oklahoma, sometimes hereinafter referred to as Seller, and City of McAlester, of PO Box 578 McAlester, OK 74502 sometimes hereinafter referred to as Purchaser,

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Hance Pyrotechnics, was the successful bidder for a pyrotechnic display (hereafter "fireworks display") to be performed and displayed on July 4th, 2011 with a rain date of July 5th, for Client, and

WHEREAS, Hance Pyrotechnics is to perform the fireworks display in a manner consistent with the highest degree of care with respect to the safety of viewers and improvements located in the area where the fireworks will be set off, and

WHEREAS, in exchange for signing this contract, Hance Pyrotechnics shall be entitled to a payment of the successfully bid amount of \$14,000.00, inclusive of tax, payable as hereafter provided.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follow:

- 1. Seller's responsibilities with respect to fireworks display: Seller agrees to provide all necessary fireworks; fireworks display materials, and the personnel necessary to perform the fireworks display. Seller shall take all steps reasonably necessary to safeguard the improvements or other property in the area of the display other than the issues for which Purchaser is responsible. Seller shall provide qualified pyrotechnicians who will deliver, set up, execute and take down the fireworks display. The pyrotechnicians shall conduct a search of the grounds after the display in an effort to locate and dispose of any unexploded fireworks. The scope and extent of such search shall be dependent upon the weather conditions, time and the completion of the display, etc. Seller shall comply with all local, state, and federal guidelines pertaining to the storing and displaying of fireworks, and obtain all necessary permits and the Purchaser will be responsible for the cost thereof.
- 2. <u>Purchaser's responsibilities with respect to fireworks display:</u> Purchaser agrees to (a) provide a sufficient area for the display, (b) provide protection of the display area to prevent unrestricted access by unauthorized persons by a means it shall determine is adequately designed for that purpose, (c) arrange adequate police or other protection to prevent spectators from entering the display area, administer proper crowd control, parking supervision, etc., and (d) arrange fire protection and emergency medical care for the health and safety of spectators and the public, and provide cleanup for the display site.
- 3. <u>Compensation to Seller:</u> Purchaser shall pay to Seller the amount of \$14,000.00. The sum shall be paid to Seller with 50% down as a non refundable deposit upon signing the contract, and remaining amount due on or before the contracted date of the display.
- 4. Weather, election to postpone: The parties understand that weather may prevent the ability to perform the fireworks display. In the event inclement weather is present on the day the display is scheduled to occur, the event may be postponed by mutual agreement by the parties. The fireworks display shall not be performed in the event any government body or agency with authority in regard to the Fireworks display shall direct, in writing or otherwise, that the display should not occur. The event will

then be rescheduled by mutual agreement by the parties to the rain date within the calendar year and The Purchaser agrees to pay an additional cost of not more than \$200.00 per day, but is limited to not more that 3 days, for security Seller will arrange for said security.

Should the event be moved to another date or a new location within the calendar year Purchaser agrees to pay Seller an additional fee equal to: 10% for a postponement notice of 6-10 days before contract date, 15% for a postponement notice of 1-5 days before contract date, and 20% of the contracted amount to cover the cost of display equipment, crews, and the dismantling of the fireworks display but only if postponed on the contracted date. Purchaser also agrees to pay all permit and insurance fees that have and will occur with the postponement.

5. <u>Insurance</u>: Seller is required to provide at its expense liability insurance coverage to cover liability in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 associated with the fireworks display. Such coverage shall name Purchaser as an additional insured.

6. Liability:

- a. <u>Performance</u>: Seller shall not be liable for any faulty performance of equipment or products that could not reasonably have been discovered prior to the commencement of the fireworks display. Should conditions arise that the fireworks display is recommended by the Seller to be rescheduled due to the above conditions, a reschedule date will be within the calendar year acceptable to both parties for the balance of the fireworks display. Seller shall use its best efforts to ensure that the display will proceed as planned and Seller will secure, prepare and deliver said fireworks and/or will make necessary substitutions of equal or greater value.
- b. <u>Harm to third parties or property:</u> Seller shall not be liable for harm to any Spectators, third parties, or improvements to property within the vicinity of the fireworks display area and that Purchaser will do everything possible to keep the fireworks display area clear of all Spectators, third parties, and improvements to property. Seller covenants that it will use its best efforts to avoid any such harm pursuant to the foregoing section.
- 7. Past due accounts: Purchaser shall be responsible for any balance that is not paid at the time it becomes due and shall bear interest at a rate of 1 3/4% per month compounded daily and for any and all collection cost, court cost, attorneys fees and all cost pertaining to the collection of payments, filings, processing, correspondence and fees for personnel and collection companies in the collection of payment.
- 8. <u>No partnership or joint venture:</u> The parties agree that Seller is a subcontractor and that there is no partnership or joint venture between the parties. The manner and means of providing the display is left to the sole discretion of Seller.
- 9. <u>Equipment</u>: Seller shall supply all necessary equipment and mortars for the fireworks display, and are the sole property of Hance Pyrotechnics.

ORDINANCE NO. __

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF McALESTER, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2361 WHICH ESTABLISHED THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010-2011; REPEALING ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council heretofore adopted Ordinance No. 2361 setting forth the Budget for Fiscal Year 2010-2011 beginning July 1, 2010 and ending June 30, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the City Departments and Divisions routinely review their budget appropriations to determine if any changes are necessary; and

WHEREAS, based upon said review the City staff now recommends that certain amendments to the Budget be considered by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has the authority to make amendments to the City Budget under Article 5, Section 5.07 (b) of the new City Charter as well as State law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the proposed amendment to the FY 2010-2011 Budget, with the revenues and expenditures therein contained, is in the best interest of the City; and therefore, desires to adopt the same by formal action.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McALESTER, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1: The proposed amendment to the FY 2010-2011 Budget of the City of McAlester, Oklahoma, as heretofore adopted by Ordinance, as summarized in Exhibit A1, which is attached hereto and fully incorporated herein by reference, be, and the same hereby are, completely adopted and approved as an amendment to the said FY 2010-2011 Budget.

SECTION 2: All portions of the existing FY 2010-2011 Budget, Ordinance No. 2361 except as specifically herein amended, shall remain in full force and effect, and not be otherwise affected by the adoption of the amendatory ordinance.

SECTION 3: That all other ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict or inconsistency and all other ordinances not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: Should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the

same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part or parts as declared to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5: That an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and for the provision of the public peace, health and safety, by reason whereof it is necessary that all acts take effect immediately and be in full force and effect from, and after the passage and approval.

PASSED and the EMERGENCY CLAUSE ruled on separately this 22nd day of March, 2011.
