The McAlester City Council met in Special session on Tuesday, March 8, 2011 at 5:45 P.M. after proper notice and agenda was posted, March 7, 2011 at 8:12 A.M.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Priddle called the meeting to order.

Consider, and Act to approve and direct the filing of a declaratory judgment action in the District Court of Pittsburg County, Oklahoma against the IAFF and Arbitrator to determine the issues related to the City's right to call a popular election to resolve the dispute resulting from the current labor negotiations and arbitration, authorizing the City Attorney to file the action and the Mayor and Clerk to sign all necessary documents on behalf of the City.

Councilman Harrison moved to approve and direct the filing of a declaratory judgment action in the District Court of Pittsburg County, Oklahoma against the IAFF and Arbitrator to determine the issues related to the City's right to call a popular election to resolve the dispute resulting from the current labor negotiations and arbitration, authorizing the City Attorney to file the action and the Mayor and Clerk to sign all necessary documents on behalf of the City. Before the vote, Mr. Ervin stated that the City Attorney's office had been directed to prepare a petition to be filed in the district court which he anticipated would be ready in its final draft for filing Wednesday, March 9, 2011. He explained the activities that had brought about this action by the Council. He commented that if the process was not completed before the end of the fiscal year there would not be a collective bargaining agreement between the City of McAlester and the IAFF and rather than having the City and the local union denied the opportunity to contract this year he felt it was important to file the declaratory judgment action.
