The project typical section calls for the use of Subgrade Method B to establish the subgrade on 17<sup>th</sup> Street, from South Avenue to Comanche Avenue. During the execution of this work, the Contractor has encountered a variance of subgrade material ranging from rock to a fat clay material. The Contractor has attempted to "rip", dry and rework the subgrade material to meet the Specification requirements with success throughout the majority of the project limits.

However, there are isolated areas that remain unsuitable and are not drying out. These areas have been discussed at length and all parties propose to proceed with the addition of a geogrid reinforcement in these areas to "bridge" the unsuitable material in order to move forward with the construction of this project.

This extra work falls under the provisions of Specification Section 109.04, "Differing Site Conditions, Changes, and Extra Work". The attached cost breakdown has been compiled in accordance with the Specifications and industry accepted standards for determining a fair and equitable price for the additional work. This price is based upon estimated labor, material, equipment costs and associated markups for overhead and profit.

There were 10 calendar days when the progress was stalled due to the discussions surrounding the alternatives available to bridge areas of unsuitable subgrade material. This change order proposal includes a request to add those days to the contract as the delay was a result of the unknown field conditions.

17th Street Roadway Improvements

We have reviewed the Daily Work Reports to determine the impact to the critical path based upon weather days. This typically results from a rain or snow event occurring followed by days of no work due to conditions not being conducive to perform the work activities critical to contract completion. In addition to weather, there were days that were impacted by discovering unmarked utilities that impacted the progress of work. From this review, we agreed upon 30 calendar days that were affected in accordance with the 2009 Specifications, Section 108.07(1).

An additional side effect of the unsuitable fill materials located along the outside edge of pavement was the need to change the planned approach of paving. The Contractor will have to change his paving method from utilizing a slip-form paver to setting forms and hand pouring due to the inability to construct a working platform to run the paver across. This results in a projected increase of 10 calendar days to complete the paving operations and associated cure time required.

These calendar impacts result in the request represented by Change Order No. 4 to add 40 calendar days to the contract time. This addition of time will adjust the completion date to August 27, 2014.
