The McAlester City Council met in a Regular session on Tuesday, October 22, 2019, at 6:00 P.M. after proper notice and agenda was posted, October 21, 2019 at 2:30 P.M.

Call to Order

Mayor Browne presented Officer Colby Barnett as October Employee of the Month. Officer Barnett received a Certificate of Appreciation, a plaque, a portfolio, one (1) day paid leave and a gift card.

Mayor Browne issued a proclamation declaring October as Breast Cancer Awareness Month.

Sharon Hall, CEO Caring Hands Healthcare Centers of McAlester and Hartshorne addressed the Council informing them that in honor of Breast Cancer Month and Women's Health Month their facilities were offering free screenings to any woman through the thirty-first (31st).

Mayor Browne issued a proclamation declaring October as Domestic Violence Month.

Amanda Prewett, Assistant Program Director of the KIBOIS Community Action Domestic Violence Program addressed the Council explaining that there was a shelter in McAlester. She informed them that the statistics had changed and Oklahoma was now ranked as 20th in the nation. She added that decline was due to the hard work of the McAlester Police Department and the programs advocates.

Vice-Mayor Stevens inquired about the payment for ice skates out of the Tourism Fund and the purchase of folding tables out of the Tourism Fund.

Manager Stasiak informed the Council that the skates that had came with the ice rink were not good and this purchase was for better skates. He added these skates would improve the skating experience. Manager Stasiak stated that he would have to look in to the purchase of the folding tables. He commented that the transaction could be reallocated to the Expo Fund if necessary.

Manager Stasiak explained that the payment from the Public Works Authority in the amount of \$50,000.00 to Bates Instrumentation had been entered off of the P.O. but that item would be voided and the correct amount of \$47,717.00 would be paid. He added that the payment from the Infrastructure Fund in the amount of \$25,000.00 to Bates Instrumentation would also be voided and the correct amount of \$24,158.07 would be paid.

Manager Stasiak reviewed the filing dates and the dates for the Primary and General Elections.

Mayor Browne asked if the date for a run-off needed to be set.

Attorney Ervin commented that date did not need to be set at this time.

There was a brief discussion concerning a run-off election, and why the filing dates were in December instead of the dates stated in the City's Charter.

A motion to approve RESOLUTION NO. 19-22, setting the 2020 Council election dates for Wards 1, 3, 5 and Mayor was made by Councilman Smith and seconded by Councilman Brown. There was no further discussion, and the vote was taken as follows:

2. Consider and act upon, an ordinance of the City of McAlester amending Chapter 102, Article V, Bicycles, Division 2, License, to establish updated processes for bicycle registration with the police department. (Gary Wansick, Chief of Police)

Executive Summary

Motion to pass and approve an Ordinance to amend Chapter 102, Article V, Bicycles, Division 2, License, and establish updated processes for bicycle registration with the police department.

Chief Wansick addressed the Council explaining that the ordinance was being changed some. He stated that the department's records management system had been updated to include a bicycle registration section. He explained the information that could be entered into the system. He added that with the registration of bicycles the department should be able to recover stolen bicycles more easily.

There was discussion concerning a penalty for not registering a bicycle, what this process would cost the City, where stolen bikes were being found, the average cost of bicycles, what prompted an officer to stop a person on a bicycles, the hours that someone could come to the department and register their bicycles, the cost to register a bicycle and adding a penalty for non-registration to the code at a later meeting.

3. Consider and act upon, an ordinance of the City of McAlester establishing fees to be charged to property owners when a property owner requests the City install or repair tinhorns/culverts on private property, and establishing a permit fee to the property owner for the permit to install or repair the tinhorn/culvert. (Toni Ervin, Assistant City Manager)

Executive Summary

Motion to pass and approve an Ordinance to charge fees to property owners for the City to install or repair tinhorns/culverts on private property and establish a permit fee to property owners for the permit to have any work performed on the property.

Assistant Manager Ervin addressed the Council explaining that this ordinance went with the Master Drainage Plan. She commented that this would aid in addressing the mis sizing of tin horns that were being installed in the City. She added that it set the permit fee for someone to install the tin horn themselves or the fee for the City to install the tin horn.

There was discussion concerning how the City currently prioritized tin horn installation, where the fees collected would be allocated, if the City would have any liability for installing tin horns, who would be approving the installations of tin horns and how the size of the tin horn was determined.

This change order is for an additional service connection, relocating a storage building out of an easement and to add 60 days to the substantial completion date, extending it to October 19, 2019 for the 2018 CDBG Sewer Project. (Robert Vaughan, Infrastructure Solutions Group)

Executive Summary

Motion to authorize the Mayor to sign Change Order #1 from Built Right Construction in the amount of \$4,550.00. This change order is for an additional service connection, relocating a storage building out of an easement and to add 60 days to the substantial completion date, extending it to October 19, 2019 for the 2018 CDBG Sewer Project.

Robert Vaughan, PE Branch Manager Infrastructure Solutions Group, addressed the Council explaining that he had distributed an amendment to the Council that added a manhole for an unknown sewer line that was not on the City's maps. He commented that the addition of this additional sewer line and manhole would remedy a problem with sewer backing up on 15th Street.

There was discussion concerning who should pay for this extra work, why the City was absorbing the cost, what caused the problems with this project, and the City working on obtaining a new easement in the area of the problems.

A motion was made by Councilman Read and seconded by Councilman Smith to authorize authorizing the Mayor to sign Change Order #1 from Built Right Construction in the amount of \$10,950.00. This change order is for an additional service connection, relocating a storage building out of an easement and to add 60 days to the substantial completion date, extending it to October 19, 2019 for the 2018 CDBG Sewer Project.

During her review she explained that this amendment would appropriate funds for Fire Severance/Unused leave over \$25,000.00, lapse and reappropriate funds for ongoing 2018-2019 Capital projects, appropriate funds for 2019 CDBG projects and appropriate funds for Streetscape project.

She commented that in the General Fund revenues were at 24.20% and expenditures were at 25.63%. The Public Works Fund revenues were at 24.40% and expenditures were at 19.62%. she commented that sales tax and use tax were doing well but the water sales were low due to a very wet year. she then briefly reviewed the Treasury report.

No action was taken on this item.

7. Consider and act upon, a Memorandum of Understanding between the McAlester Public Works Authority and the Board of Education of Independent School District No. 80, Pittsburg County, Oklahoma that authorizes the release of funds derived from City Ordinance 2159, for the acquisition, construction, and renovation of educational facilities. (Peter Stasiak, City Manager, Randy Hughes, MPS Superintendent)

Executive Summary

Motion to approve the Memorandum of Understanding that conveys to ISDA80 the sum of \$1,155,236.00 to be used for the acquisition, construction, and renovation for McAlester Public Schools.

Assistant Manager Ervin addressed the Council explaining that all paperwork was in order and this was for the Schools project at Puterbaugh. She added that this was for a prior fiscal year so the funds had to be brought forward and the check would be processed and on the next Council meeting claims list.

Mayor Browne asked about how the School system could request the balance in the account.

Assistant Manager Ervin explained that when the School identified the project and requested the funds, they would then be able to get the balance. She reminded the Council that this bond also included parts of the Frink and Krebs School Districts so they would also receive funds from that account. She added that she did not process the checks until the request was approved by the Council.

There was no further discussion, and a motion to approve a Memorandum of Understanding between the McAlester Public Works Authority and the Board of Education of Independent School District No. 80, Pittsburg County, Oklahoma that authorizes the release of funds derived from City Ordinance 2159, for the acquisition, construction, and renovation of educational facilities in the amount of \$1,155,236.00 was made by Councilman Smith. The motion was seconded by Vice-Mayor Stevens, and the vote was taken as follows:

8. Presentation on the Action Plan for the Moving McAlester Forward 2040 Comprehensive Plan. (Jayme Clifton, Community Development Director)

Executive Summary Presentation.

Director Clifton addressed the Council presenting the Action Plan for the City's new Comprehensive Plan. During her presentation Director Clifton reviewed the seven (7) areas of the Vison with forty-two (42) recommendations. She added that public input was accepted throughout the development of both the Comprehensive Plan and the Action Plan. She stated that the Action Plan would prevent the Comprehensive Plan from setting on a shelf and not being followed.

Director Clifton commented that the following six (6) Key initiatives were at the top of the list: Wastewater Analysis and Reconstruction; Crime Prevention; Stormwater Implementation and Education; Employee Satisfaction and Retention; Expansion of EMS Transport Services and Sidewalk and Trails Connectivity. She reviewed each of the initiatives and how they affected the citizens and how they could be addressed and/or improved. In conclusion of her review, Director Clifton stated that there would be monthly meetings on the action plan items, quarterly meetings for key staff and quarterly updates furnished.

Councilman Prichard asked why none of the initiatives included land use and design.

Director Clifton commented that the seven (7) areas seemed to be the most pressing and some of the other areas would be moving along in the background.

There was discussion concerning the action plan not aligning with the Comprehensive Plan, City staff not addressing the bulk of what the plan recommending, and funding allowing the accomplishment of the recommendations.

Vice-Mayor Stevens commented that in the beginning he had felt the Comprehensive Plan was an incredible waste of money but at the end of the process got a packet. He thought this would be a good re-imagining of where McAlester could go. He added that that he did not think the Plan was moving us forward and we're not taking progressive steps to make the City progressive.

No action was taken on this item.

New Business

Any matter not known or which could not have been reasonably foreseen prior to the time of posting the Agenda in accordance with Sec. 311.9, Title 25, Oklahoma State Statutes.

There was no new business.

City Manager's Report

• Report on activities for the past two weeks.

Manager Stasiak informed the Council that the twenty-inch (20") water line repair had started. The thirty-inch (30") water line hot tap was accomplished. The Washington Ave. and 5th Street Round-about bid opening was scheduled for October 31st and he projected that construction on that project would begin after the first of the year. He stated that the Business 69 and Choctaw Ave. traffic lights had been out since the beginning of the Streetscape project, the City had requested that the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to analyze if those lights needed to be there. ODOT came back to the City and said the lights did not need to be there. He informed the Council that the easements for the Saunier Way Canal Bank Stabilization were being worked on. He added that the canal was moving and citizens were losing land. He informed the Council that the pumps in the Coal Creek Pump Station had been disconnected and hoped to be removed next week and sent off for repair. He added that hopefully that pump station would be back online in 2020 as a secondary water source for the City.

Remarks and Inquiries by City Council

Councilwoman Harrison thanked the Kibois Community Action and Caring Hands for attending the meeting and thanked the City Clerk for preparing the proclamations. She announced that "Make a Difference Day' was this Saturday, October 26th. she stated that the Oklahoma Geological Historical Society would be having a history lesson at the North Town Cemetery on Tuesday, October 26th at 5:30 P.M.

Councilman Prichard asked about the Streetlights on Choctaw not working, if the City had hired a CFO, a UTM manager, light at Third and Choctaw and asked about the quality of the water from the Coal Creek pump station.

Manager Stasiak explained that the City had hired an electrician to install those lights but he had quit so now was looking to hire another electrician. He stated that the City was making an offer to another person for the CFO position, they were in the process of promoting internally for the UTM manager and would be hiring a foreman to work directly with that employee. He stated that it would be a mixed system and would be tested by the City's labs.

Councilman Brown commended Officer Barnett for the steps he took to return the leg braces to the young girl.

Councilmen Smith, Stevens and Read did not have any comments for the evening.

Mayor's Comments and Committee Appointments

Mayor Browne commented on the "Indigenous Peoples Day" event at Chadick Park and the SEAK function at Chadick Park. He announced the dedication of the 270 Bridge over 69 Highway in honor of Sgt. Jason McCluskey. He added that the Army, ODOT and the City would be working together on the dedication.

1: Discussion on Special Permitting Requirements for New Healthcare Facilities within the City of McAlester with a possible amendment to the existing ordinance.

David Keith, CEO McAlester Regional Health Center addressed the Council explaining that communities should have ordinances that regulated the healthcare facilities within the communities. He added that this meeting would be used to discuss what would be important to add to the existing ordinance. He then introduced Karen S. Rieger with Crowe & Dunlevy Attorneys and Counselors At Law.

Ms. Rieger addressed the Council briefly reviewing the current permit requirements. She then reviewed the proposed changes to the City's ordinance. During her review she highlighted the reasons for the Special Permit some of which were to verify that a new provider would not cause a financial or staffing hardship on existing healthcare facilities, verify that the City's infrastructure could support a new facility and verify that the new provider would not cause an increase in the cost of healthcare. She commented on some adverse effects a new provider could potentially cause, and the other communities that had Special Healthcare permitting requirements. Ms. Rieger stated that Oklahoma cities and counties had the authority to regulate

hospitals and to promote health through zoning. She briefly reviewed the permit process, the creation of the Medical Development Board, what facilities this permit would apply to, and the filing fee.

There was discussion concerning the creation of the proposed ordinance amendments, the impact of stand alone Emergency Rooms have on a community, if this change would create a roadblock to needed health services, if the stand alone facilities would direct patience to the McAlester Regional Health Center, the feasibility study, if the legal points had been derived from case law, the makeup of the Medical Development Board, what additional healthcare services the City of McAlester could use, how this would affect the hospital if they decided to expand into new areas and if this change if approved would affect independent physicians.

The offices to be voted upon in said election shall be the Office of Mayor of the City of McAlester, and every qualified elector of the City of McAlester shall be entitled to vote for one candidate for said office; and the Offices of Councilman for wards 1, 3 and 5 of the City of McAlester; and every qualified elector of each of said wards shall be entitled to vote for one candidate for Councilman from each ward.
- 3. The filing period for said election shall begin at 8:00 A.M., December 16, 2019, and expire at 5:00 P.M., December 18, 2019.
- 4. Persons qualified to file for the Office of Mayor are qualified electors of the City of McAlester, who are at least 25 years of age, and who have resided in the City of McAlester at least two (2) years.

- 5. Persons qualified for the Office of Councilman are qualified electors of the City of McAlester, who are at least 25 years of age, who have resided in the City of McAlester at least two (2) years, and who have resided for a period of one (1) year in the ward for which they wish to file.
- 6. Both the Primary and General Election shall be non-partisan and no party designation or emblem shall be placed on the ballots.
- 7. The General Election so provided shall be held on the 7th day of April 2020, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M.
- 8. There shall be no required filing fee for the Office of Councilman or Mayor.
- 9. Pursuant to 26 O.S. § 13-103, the following precincts are located entirely or partially within the McAlester city limits and will be opened for the above referenced election.






GENERAL FUND REVENUES
