## PLOT PLAN REQUIREMENTS FOR INGROUND & SEMI-INGROUND SWIMMING POOL CONSTRUCTION

1. The plot plan shall be prepared by a surveyor, architect or engineer (sealed, signed, and dated by TN licensed professional).
2. The plot plan shall depict all structures on the premises, setbacks, easements, any flood hazard zones on the property, utilities, stormwater and drainage features, hardscape features, landscaping, pool deck, retaining walls, pool equipment, swimming pools, hot tubs, and other significant elements. The plot plan shall be dimensioned and scaled accurately for these elements.
3. Elements shall be on one plan sheet to show their relationship to one other.
4. Elements shall be labeled "existing" and "proposed."
5. On lots where the side setbacks are 10 feet or less, pool equipment shall be located in the rear yard and at least 10 feet from the side or rear property line.
  - **Exception:** Pool equipment may be located in side yard provided 15 feet is maintained from any property line.
6. The plot plan shall include the location and details of fencing surrounding the pool including gates, fence height and type construction (e.g. wooden, aluminum, chain link, & etc.).
7. Where the area of swimming pool construction is on a slope of 15% or greater, a topographic detail showing elevations at 2 feet intervals shall be provided. (Geotechnical engineering may be required.)
