



Dear Oronoko Charter Township Voter:

Do you want to skip the long lines on Election Day and vote by mail? Then you can request to be placed on the township's Permanent Absent Voter List. As of the 2020 Elections, ALL registered voters in Michigan may request an Absent Voter Ballot without providing a reason. Once you are on this permanent list, you do not need to sign up to be on it again (and you will remain on it as long as you are a resident of this township or until you request to be removed from the list).

If you choose to be added to this list, you will automatically receive an "Absent Voter Ballot Application" approximately 45 days before EVERY upcoming Election. This can serve one of two purposes:

- You can complete the Absent Voter Ballot Application and receive your ballot by mail, or
- The Application may simply serve as a reminder of an upcoming Election.

All you need to do is fill out the Application and return it to the Clerk's office at the Township Hall. Upon receiving your completed Application, you will be issued a ballot which may be voted in the privacy of your home and then returned to the Township Hall.

If you do not return your Application, you will not receive a ballot. You can then vote in person in the precinct on Election day. So...if you would like to be on this permanent list, please fill out the information requested in the box below and return this letter to the township hall (see address at bottom of letter).
