





Project History/Funding

#1 Project on 6 year Transportation Improvement Plan **Transportation Improvement Board awarded Shelton** \$410,400 (Overlay-10% match) and \$350,000 (Sidewalk-53% match) funding November 16, 2019.

Safe Routes to School

Safe Routes to School (three locations). One location is in Railroad Ave. \$ 317,447 of the \$770,173 grant will be spent at the intersection of 9th and Railroad Ave. Grant has a 13.5% match requirement.






