#### **GREETINGS:**

To either of the Constables of the Town of Swansea,

In the name of the Commonwealth you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town who are qualified to vote in elections and Town affairs to meet at the JOSEPH CASE HIGH SCHOOL, 70 SCHOOL STREET, Swansea, Massachusetts, on MONDAY, the **TWENTIETH** (20<sup>th</sup>) day of MAY, 2024 at SEVEN-O'CLOCK P.M., then and there to act on the following articles in the warrant:

Article 1:

To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds a sum not to exceed \$58,530.78 from the Health Insurance Trust to the Other Post Employment Benefits Liability Trust Fund or take any other action relative thereto. (*Transfer from Health Insurance Trust*)

Article 2:

To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds a sum not to exceed \$98,500 to purchase a turf mower for the Parks and Recreation Department, or take any other action relative thereto. (*Certified Free Cash*)

Article 3:

To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds a sum not to exceed \$50,000 to purchase an infield machine for the Parks and Recreation Department, or take any other action relative thereto. (Certified Free Cash)

Article 4:

To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds a sum not to exceed \$115,000 to fund Owners Project Manager and design services for the renovation, repair, or expansion of the Annex building at 68 Stevens Road, and oversight of the same, to house municipal departments, or take any other action relative thereto. (Certified Free Cash)

#### Advisory and Finance Recommends Unanimously (14-0)

Article 5:

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from the Beach Receipts Reserved Account a sum not to exceed \$20,000 to fund a grant match for the Harbor Advisory Plan, or take any other action relative thereto. (*Transfer from Beach Receipts*)

#### Advisory and Finance Recommends Unanimously (14-0)

Article 6:

To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds a sum not to exceed \$1,678,384 to fund the installation of sewer infrastructure along Route 6 at Gardners Neck Road and Route 6 at Route 118 in coordination with MassDOT reconstruction of same, or take any other action relative thereto. (transfer from Assessors Overlay released balance; supplement with Certified Free Cash)

Advisory and Finance Recommends Unanimously (14-0)
