Affirmation of proper public notice of meeting.

The meeting was properly noticed.

Approve minutes from February and March meetings.

Roger moved to approve the February and March meeting minutes, second by Darrel. There was a discussion about amending the February minutes. Eric moved to amend the minutes as discussed, second by Darrel. Motion carried. Motion carried to approve minutes for February and March.

Project updates:

Virtualization: Choose project proposal

Connie stated that she sent out four RFP's. Locknet and 3RT met with her to determine the needs for the Virtualization project. 3RT was the only company to submit a proposal. Connie stated that 3RT sent her an email letting her know that Dell had additional incentives if the hardware was ordered by May 2. The committee discussed the proposal. Roger moved to have Connie get a second quote with the discount on it and work with Corp Counsel and when it's to her satisfaction approve it up to and not to exceed the current proposal, second by Darrel. Motion carried.

Website Update: Connie said that Christina didn't feel that she needed to come to the IT committee meeting because she just got the contract back from the Corporation Counsel and there was really nothing to report yet.

Board Tablets:

Roger was concerned that citizens attending meetings wouldn't have access to the agenda or other documents. The committee discussed the issue. Darrel had concerns about board supervisors using their own personal devices rather than county tablets. It was discussed and agreed that the supervisors could use their own devices, but the IT Department will not support them.
