Public Input Requested this week on Proposed Playground and Accessibility Improvements at Memorial Park

Notice is hereby given of a five-day public comment period on a potential park project to be submitted for funding through the Hamilton County Community Development Block Grant COVID-19 (CDBG-CV) Program. Eligible CDBG-CV projects are for economic development, public facilities, or public infrastructure projects.

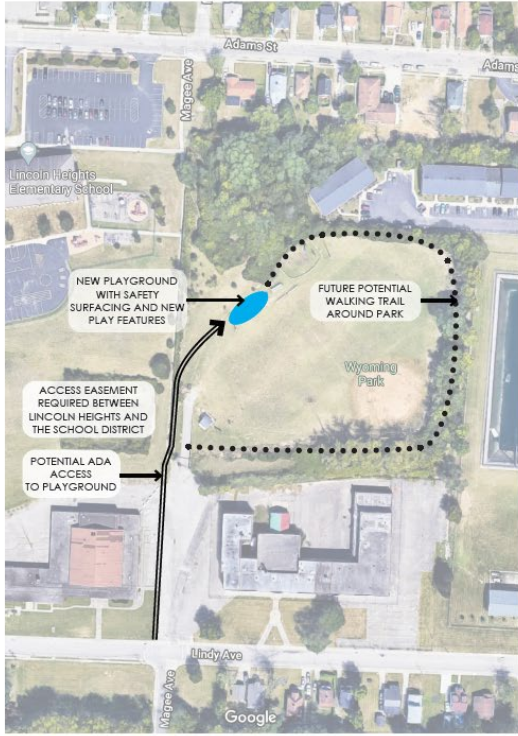
The Village of Lincoln Heights plans to apply for \$250,000 in CDBG-CV funding to pay for playground and ADA improvements to Memorial Park (see attached).

The public comment period will begin at noon on October 28, 2020 and will end on November 2, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.

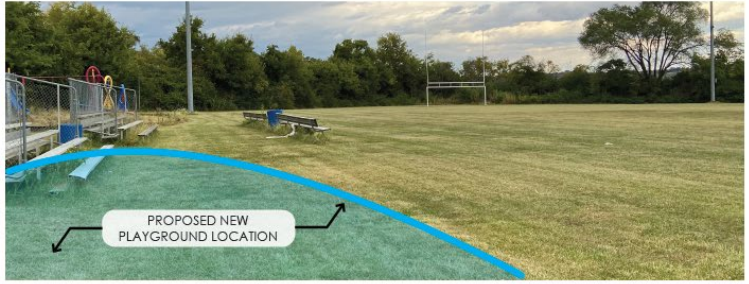
