**WHEREAS,** Section 11.03 of the Village Charter establishes a Recreation Commission ("Commission") consisting of five members who serve 4-year staggered terms;


**WHEREAS,** Vacancies exist on the Commission which need to be filled.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:


**SECTION I** Schamara Washington is hereby appointed to the Commission. Her appointment is retroactive to January 1, 2019 ending on December 31, 2022.
