**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO PURCHASE TWO PARCELS
FROM THE BOARD OF EDUCATION, PRINCETON SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE LINCOLN
HEIGHTS SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROJECT**

WHEREAS, The Safe Routes to School Program provides money through the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation, to promote walking and bicycling to school through infrastructure improvements, enforcement tools, safety education, and incentives;

WHEREAS, The Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio is finalizing the right of way plans for its Safe Routes to School Project regarding Lincoln Heights Elementary, and its engineers have determined that there is a need to purchase two small parcels of land owned by the Board of Education, Princeton City School District ("PCSD"), which surround Lincoln Heights Elementary School;

WHEREAS, One parcel is for curb ramp improvements, and the other parcel is for a new flashing speed limit sign ("Parcels") ;as depicted on the right away plans attached hereto as EXHIBIT #A.

WHEREAS, the PCSD will sell the Parcels to the Village of Lincoln Heights for one dollar; and

WHEREAS, The Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights has determined it is in the best interest of the residents of the Village of Lincoln Heights to purchase the Parcels from the PCSD so that it may improve the safety of the area surrounding the Lincoln Heights Elementary School.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio that:

SECTION I The Village Manager is hereby authorized to purchase the Parcels of land from the PCSD for one dollar.

SECTION II The Village Manager, after consulting with the Law Director, is hereby authorized to sign a purchase contract for the Parcels on behalf of the Village of Lincoln Heights.

SECTION III This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Lincoln Heights. The reason for said emergency is the need to finalize the right of way plans for the Lincoln Heights Safe Routes to School Project, which will enhance the safety of students attending Lincoln Heights Elementary School.
