**RESOLUTION TERMINATING
AGREEMENT WITH THE VILLAGE OF WOODLAWN FOR
PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE ENFORCEMENT SERVICES**

WHEREAS, The Village of Lincoln Heights and the Village of Woodlawn are neighboring municipalities; and

WHEREAS, Woodlawn and Lincoln Heights previously entered into an agreement dated February 1, 2018, whereby Woodlawn provides fire protection and emergency medical services to Lincoln Heights ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, Woodlawn and Lincoln Heights amended the Agreement so that Woodlawn could also provide Property Maintenance Code enforcement services to Lincoln Heights pursuant to that certain Addendum dated October 30, 2018 ("Addendum"); and

WHEREAS, Woodlawn and Lincoln Heights mutually desire to terminate the Addendum whereby Woodlawn provides Property Maintenance Code enforcement services to Lincoln Heights, while keeping in full force and effect the Agreement whereby Woodlawn provides fire protection and emergency medical services to Lincoln Heights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council for the Village of Lincoln Heights, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I The Addendum whereby Woodlawn provides Property Maintenance Code enforcement services to Lincoln Heights is hereby terminated pursuant to Article 5, Section 5.1 of the Addendum.

SECTION II The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Resolution and to forthwith transmit the same to the Village of Woodlawn, 10141 Woodlawn Boulevard, Woodlawn, Ohio 45215, with a copy to Emily Supinger, Village of Woodlawn Law Director, 150 East Fourth Street, 4th Floor, Cincinnati, Ohio 45202.

SECTION III This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Lincoln Heights. The reason for said emergency is the need to transfer Property Maintenance Code enforcement services back to Lincoln Heights for the benefit and safety of its residents and visitors.
