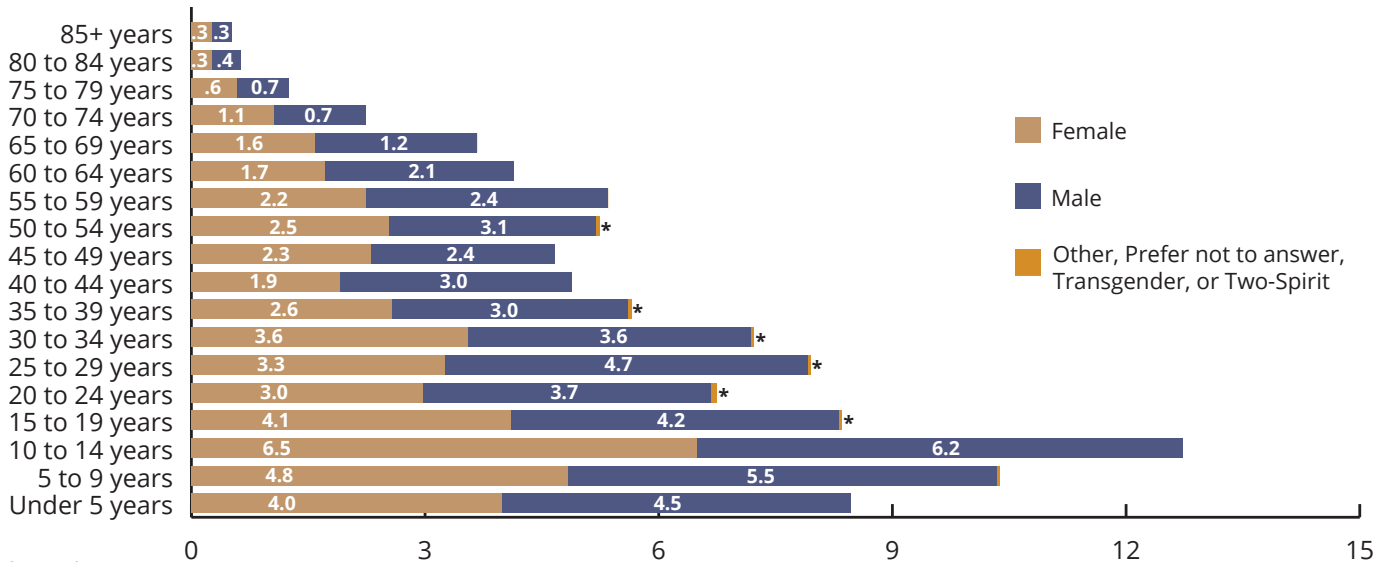

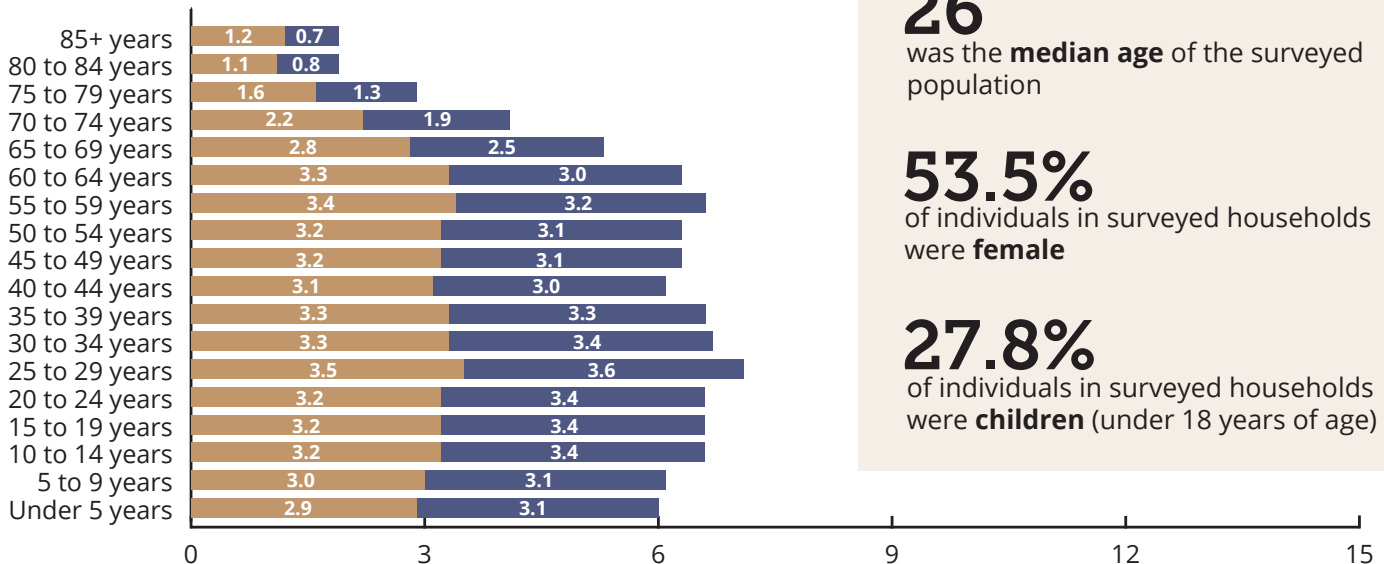

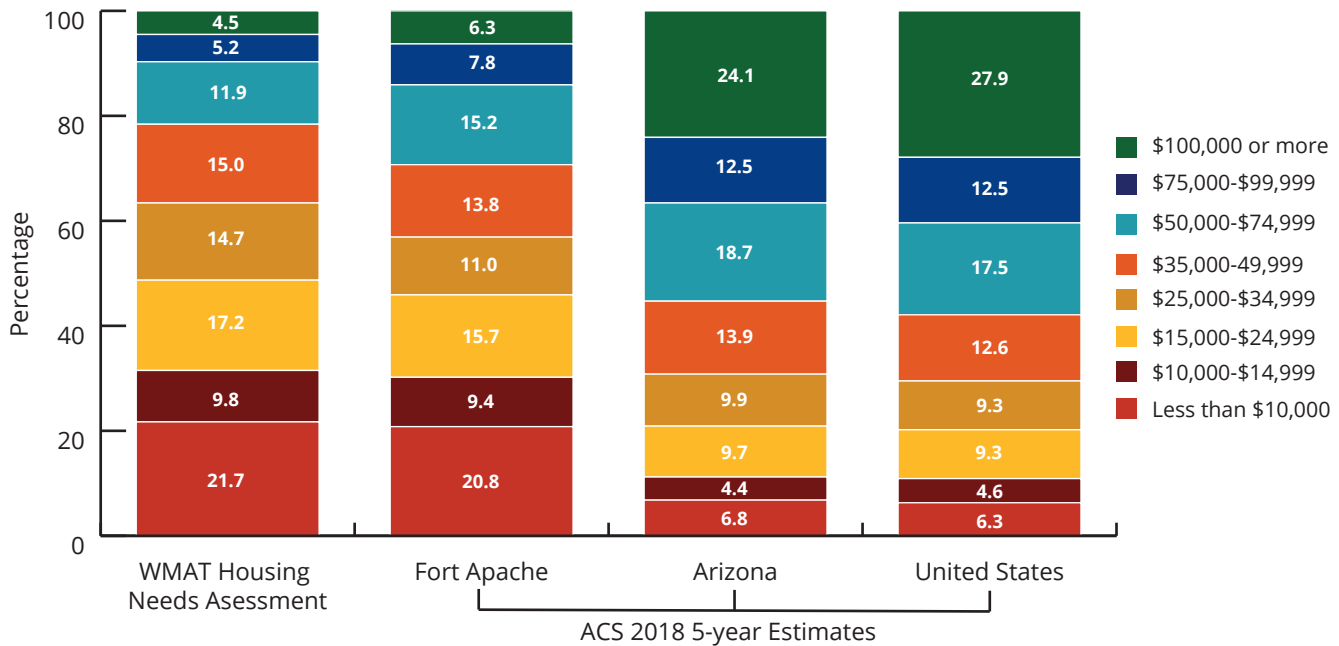

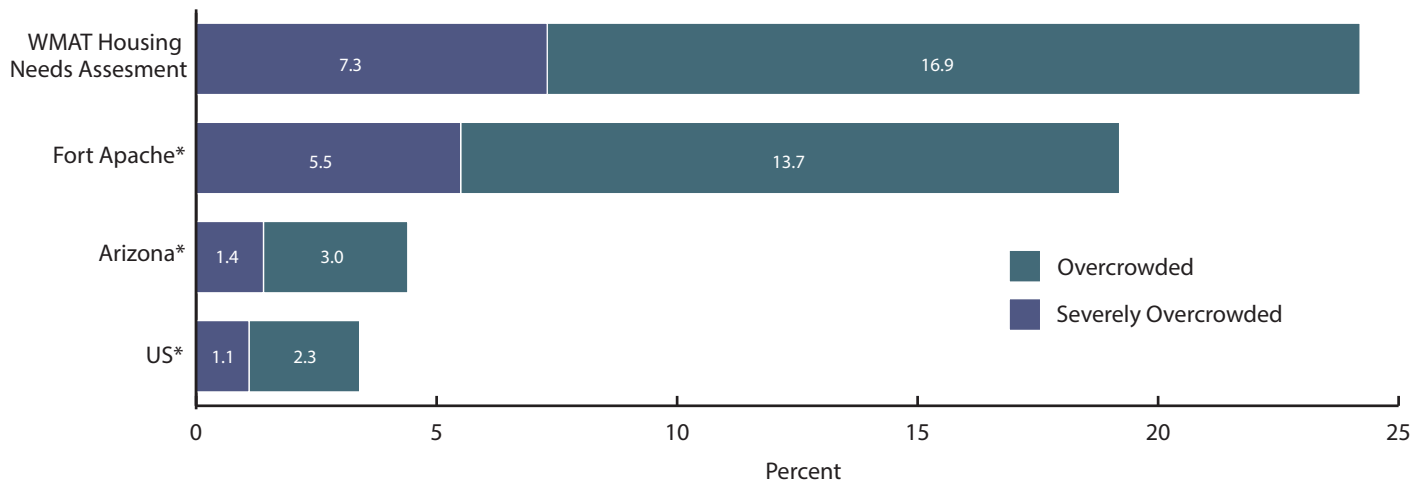

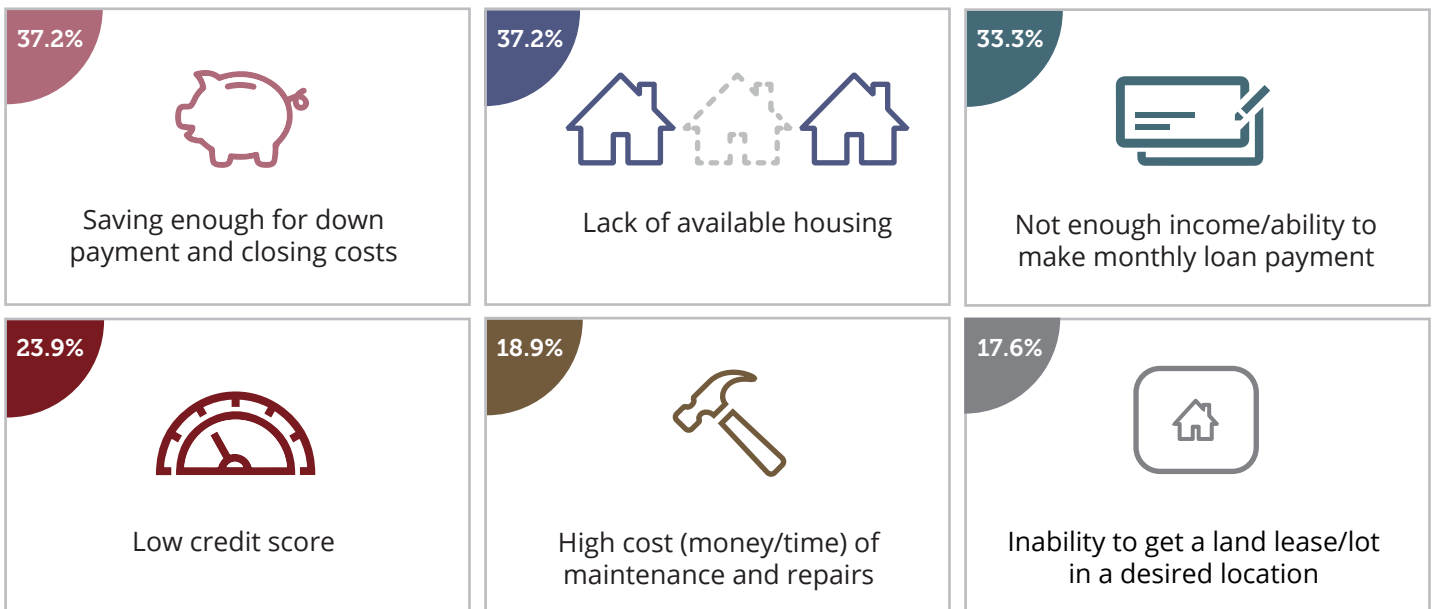

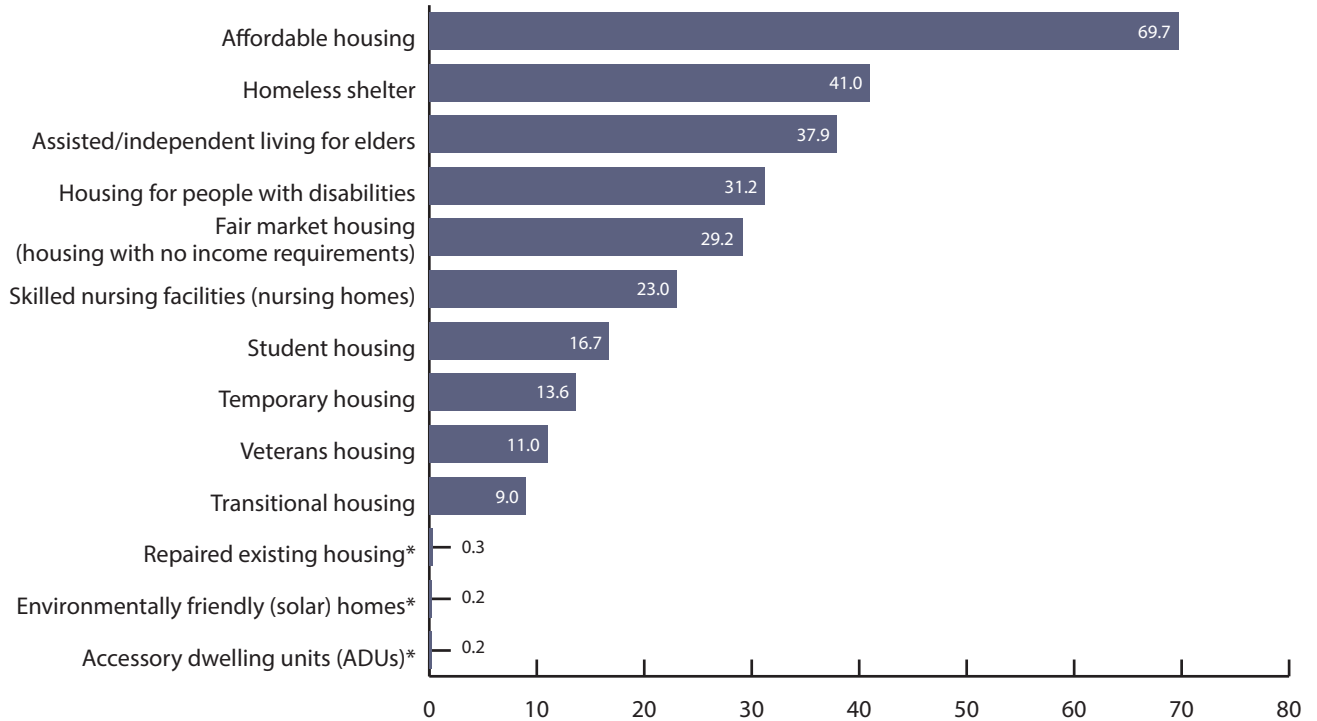
## Biggest Barriers to Homeownership (Respondent could choose up to 3)\*

## Housing Most Needed to Serve Fort Apache Community



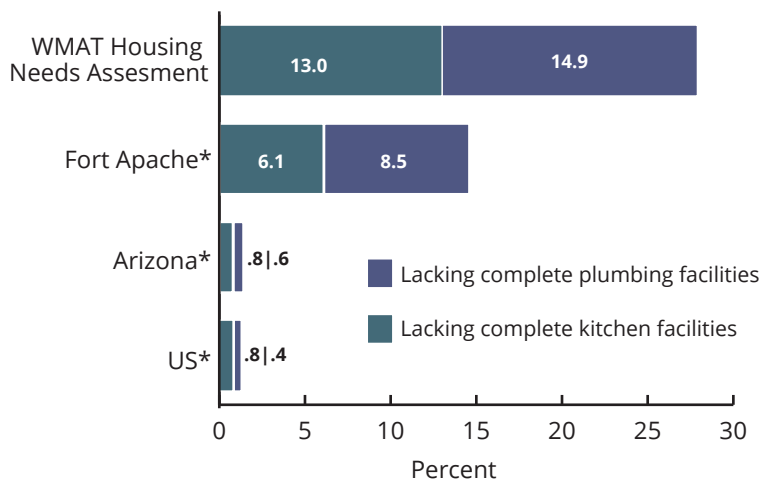

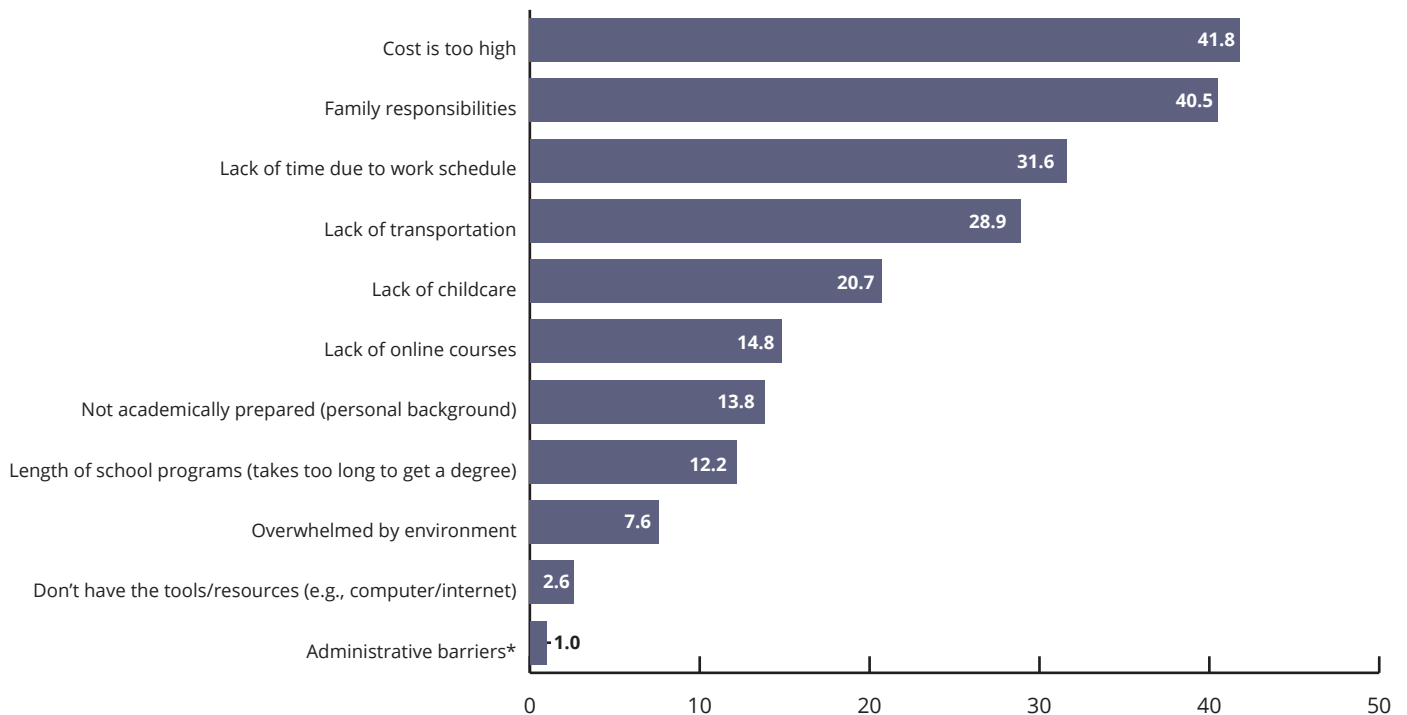

## Reported Barriers to Completing Higher Education

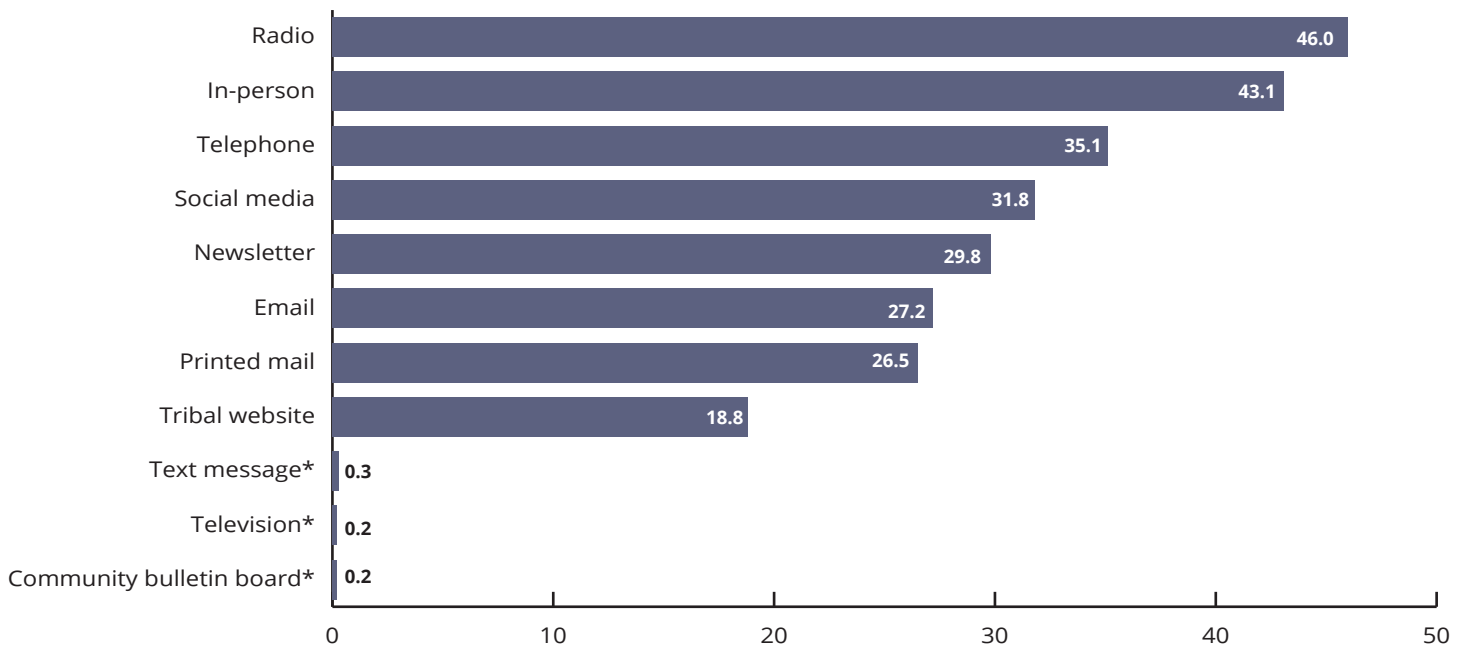

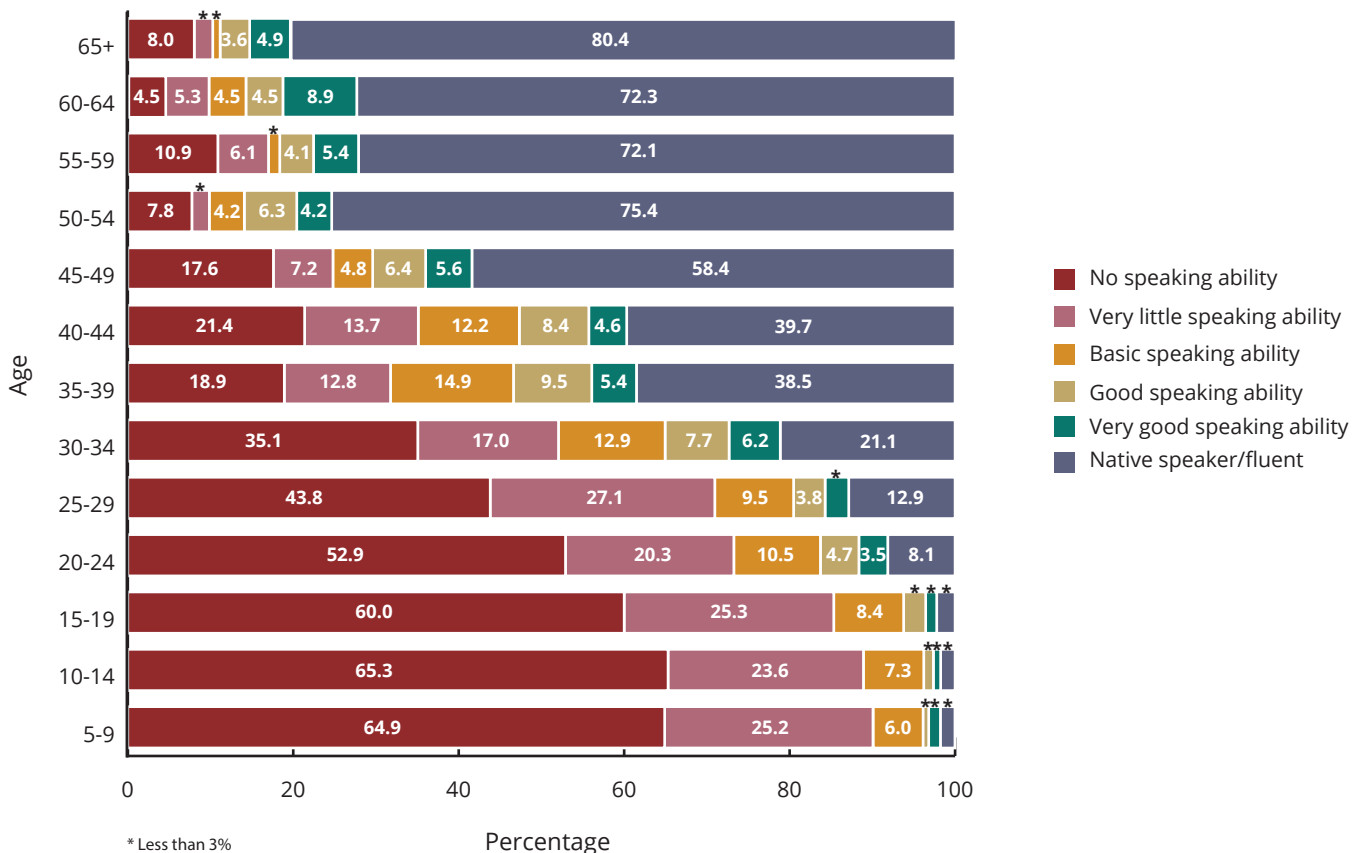
## Preferred Communication Source

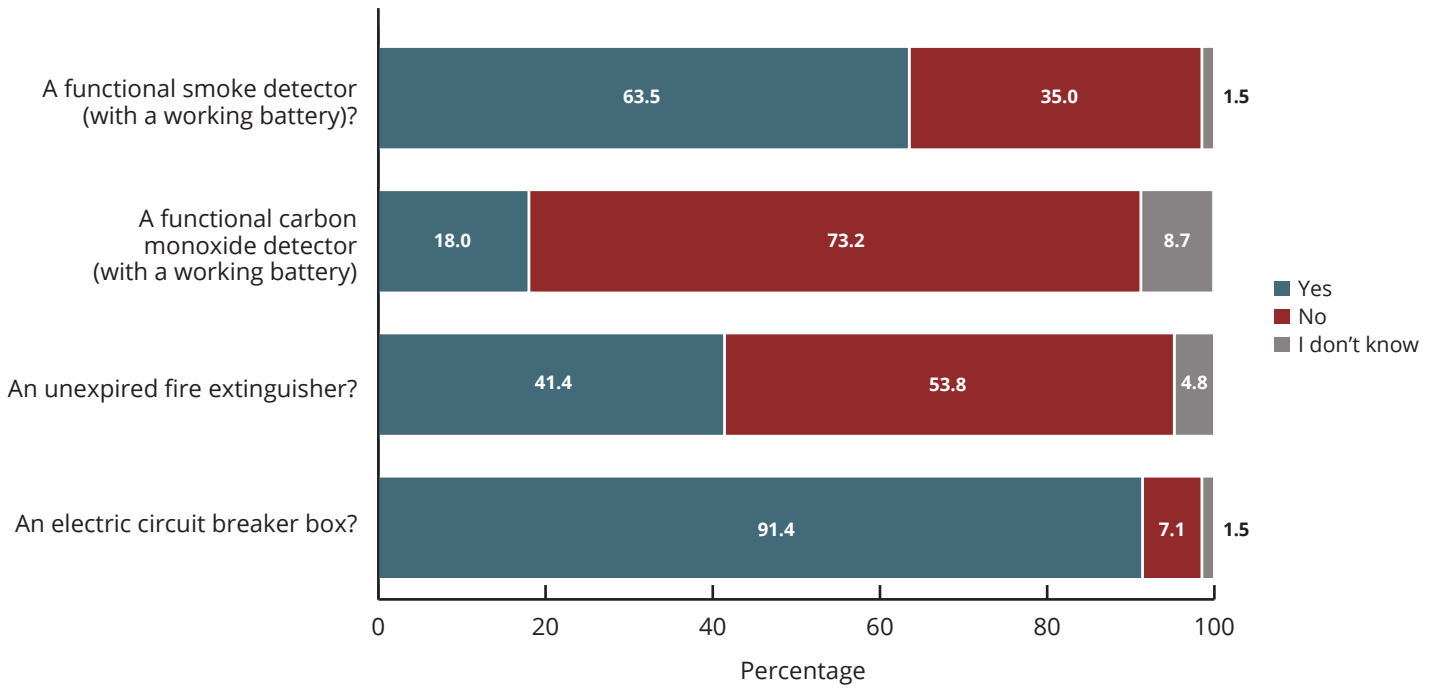
